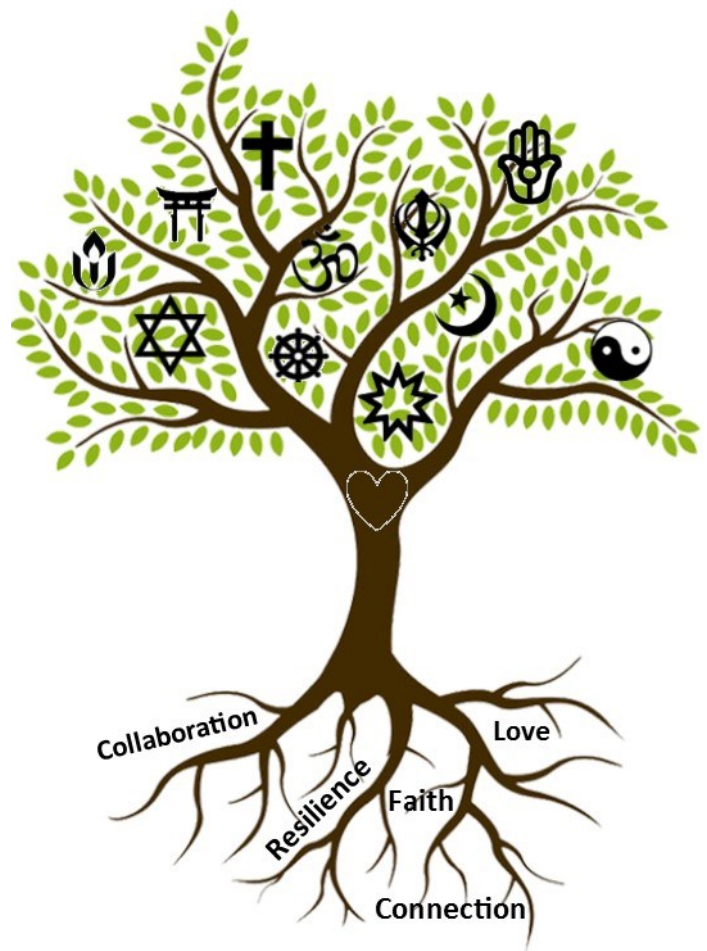
Over three years, we have been learning about the intersection of faith, trauma and resilience. Come and celebrate the blossoming and blooming of our movement.
