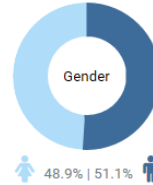

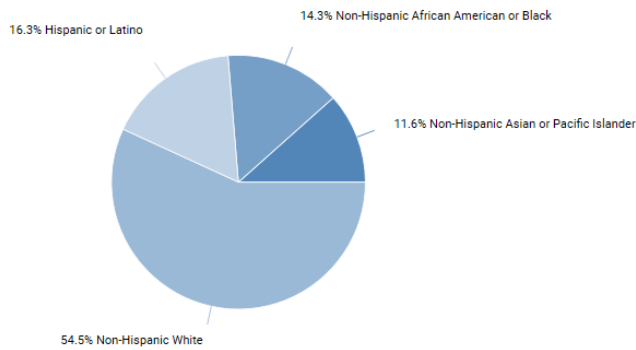

→ Edgewater had a rate of 12.2 per 100,000 for drug overdose deaths

→ Other indicators include injury and violence data
